In a Condition Assessment, we inspect the most critical components of your GCU and determine their actual condition. That way, you can take proactive steps to prevent downtime and ensure peace of mind.

How it works

A Condition Assessment is an onboard equipment survey that identifies issues before they lead to problems – and highlights potential opportunities. Although the Alfa Laval GCU is proven reliable and doesn't require intensive maintenance, we recommend a yearly Condition Assessment to minimize the risk of a breakdown and potential off-hire. The service is also a good idea when acquiring a new vessel or preparing for dry dock.

During the Condition Assessment, our certified Alfa Laval Marine Service engineers make a thorough visual inspection of your GCU's components and their mechanical condition. They closely examine the exhaust stack and combustion chamber. In addition, they check the operating parameters of the gas valve unit (GVU), burner and control system.

Following the onboard survey, we provide a detailed report with recommendations for addressing issues and optimizing GCU performance. Our clear advice will help crews operate the system more effectively, and we'll let you know of available improvements or upgrades.
